This week's Connecting Point topic reminded me of a story I read about a little girl who stood on a street corner and begged for food and money. Her clothes were tattered, and her face was dirty. A successful businessman drove by the corner, passing the girl. Upon returning home to his family, they sat down for dinner. He thought about the young girl and became

angry at God. He thought, "God, why do you allow these things to happen to people—especially this little girl? Why don't you do something to help her?" Then, he heard God in the depths of his heart say, "I did. I created you!"

Today's scripture readings remind us that we have all been uniquely gifted by God. Whether through spiritual talents, natural talents, or learned skills, the different gifts bestowed upon us are no accident. These gifts are not for our *individual* fame or advantage but rather for building up our communities and bringing the Kingdom of God to earth.

The second reading this weekend emphasizes that our gifts, although

different, come from the same Spirit—the same God. This recognition brings forth the profound truth that diversity in gifts is by divine design. Our world may value uniformity, but God calls us to celebrate our differences. Just as a body cannot function with one organ, a community thrives only when all members contribute their unique strengths. Our gifts complement one another, reflecting the beauty of God's creativity. These gifts are meant to be used for the common good in service to others.

Our task, then, is to discern those gifts and how to use them. If you are

a teacher, you nurture young minds. If you work in direct patient care, you have the gift of facilitating God's restorative grace in healing. If you are a business leader, you provide services that others need and that help them take care of their families.

Sometimes, however, fear or comparison to others can prevent us from using our gifts effectively. We may think that our gifts are not as important as those of someone more successful, or we may believe that we are not good enough. But St. Paul reminds us that all gifts, no matter how *seemingly* small, are essential. A kind word, a listening ear, or a simple



act of service can have a profound impact. As disciples of Christ, we are called to invest what we've been given—not bury it out of fear. When we step out in faith, God multiplies our efforts in wonderful ways!



Preparing for Sacraments

The children who are preparing for the Sacrament of Eucharist or Confirmation recently participated in a Rite of Enrollment at the 9:45 AM Mass on Jan. 12. This Rite provided the opportunity for our children to acknowledge and affirm the commitment they are making, receive a blessing from clergy, and for us to affirm that we will serve as role models for them and keep them in prayer.

If you would, make a note and place it in your usual prayer space, on the refrigerator, or on the visor in your car to remind you to say a prayer for all of our program participants, but most especially for those who are planning to be Confirmed or receive Eucharist for the first time.



A Resource for Catholic Parents

If you haven't heard, the Archdiocese of Detroit has made the commitment to provide a vast resource for Catholic parents. This online resource is called Compass. Compass aims to anticipate the needs of Catholic parents, accompany them through the trials and joys of family life, and point them to faithful answers to life's difficult questions.

Searching the Database

The Compass database will continue to grow as AOD personnel explore more topic areas and as new resources are developed. Individuals are encouraged to search the Compass database by using the search bar or by selecting a topic of interest. Individuals can also filter the results by audience, media type, and language.

Topic Pages

The topic pages are meant to be a quick overview of each topic area. They briefly explain the issue at hand, consider ways to anticipate the needs of your own family, and accompany families along the way. There are even links to additional resources.

Workshops

Finally, parent workshops on specific topic areas are expected to be made available to parishes and schools in the upcoming months. We will try to keep you posted. In the meantime, check out **compassforparents.org**.

Versiti Blood Drive

Did you know that January is
National Blood Donor Month, and
donating one unit of blood can save
up to three lives? On Jan. 23, from
12:30 to 5 PM, St. Therese of Lisieux
will host a Versiti Blood Drive as part
of our effort to host five such events
throughout the year to help with
the blood shortage. Versiti provides
blood to all of the Henry Ford Health
Hospitals, as well as the Corewell
Health Hospitals.

Our goal for the Versiti Blood Drive is to obtain at least 15 successful donations, but if we could get more, that would be great! Statistically, someone needs blood every two seconds! Although appointments are preferred, walk-ins will be accommodated if time permits.

If you plan on donating blood, remember to eat healthy beforehand. Consider foods high in iron, like red meat, chicken, seafood, beans, quinoa, spinach, chickpeas, lentils, peas, and pumpkin seeds. Also, vitamin C helps absorb iron, so try eating foods high in vitamin C, like oranges, citrus fruit, bell peppers, kiwifruit, strawberries, papayas, broccoli, tomatoes, kale, and snow peas. It is also recommended that



you eat breakfast and drink plenty of water before donating!

At our last blood drive, we had some people who attempted to donate but were turned down. When you come to donate blood, your blood pressure, pulse, temperature, and hemoglobin are taken. Some reasons people might not be able to donate include having either a high or low blood pressure. Blood pressures need to be lower than 180/100 at the time of donation and higher than 90/50. Your pulse should be greater than 50 and not higher than 100. A woman must have a hemoglobin level of at least 12.5g/dl and a man at least 13.0 g/dl.

Physical exam results vary throughout the day. Stress, nutrition, illness, hydration, weight, activity, environment, and even consumption of certain ingredients (salt or caffeine, for example) can affect the results of the physical exam. If your result does not meet the minimum/maximum requirement at the time of your attempted donation, you will not be permitted to donate.


