# CONNECTING POINT

Palm Sunday begins Holy Week with a striking contrast—Jesus is welcomed into Jerusalem with cheers and palm branches, but by the end of the week, those same crowds call for His crucifixion. The readings this coming weekend, especially the Passion narrative from Luke, invite us to pause and reflect on Jesus' humility through

it all.

Though He is the Son of God,
Jesus chooses to ride into the city
on a donkey—not on a horse with
soldiers accompanying Him, but
in peace and simplicity. Later, as
He is betrayed, denied, beaten,
and crucified, He never lashes out.
Instead, He prays for forgiveness for

those who hurt Him. That is humility.

So, how can we live that out in our own small ways?

Humility doesn't mean thinking less of ourselves; it means thinking of ourselves less. It's choosing to listen before speaking. It's being willing to admit when we're wrong or when




we don't have all the answers. It's noticing the needs of others—even in small ways, like letting someone go ahead in line or offering a smile when someone looks down.

In conversations, humility might look like asking questions instead of jumping to conclusions. At work or school, it might be sharing credit or offering help without needing recognition. At home, it might mean apologizing first or forgiving quickly. Jesus shows us that humility isn't weakness—it's strength under control. This Holy Week, as we

walk with Him to the cross, let's ask ourselves: Where can I choose to be more humble? During my day, how can I make room for others and God?

Small acts of humility, repeated often, shape us and open our hearts to love more like Christ—gently, patiently, and with grace.

# St. Vincent de Paul Easter Food Request



## **Easter Triduum**

The Easter Triduum, also known as the Sacred or Paschal Triduum, is a three-day period in the Catholic Church calendar. It begins on the evening of Maundy Thursday and ends with evening prayer on Easter Sunday. The Triduum is a time to celebrate the Passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It marks the most significant events of Holy Week.

Challenge yourself or a family member to attend one event during Holy Week this year that is new to you.

This is the evening Mass of the Lord's supper. Join us for this beautiful service exemplifying Jesus' humble love and new commandment. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be available until midnight.

#### Good Friday: 9 AM & 12:30 PM Stations | 1:30 PM Liturgy

Celebration of the Lord's Passion and Adoration of the Holy Cross. On this day, we recall Christ's final steps through the Stations of the Cross, which are followed by the Liturgy of the Passion.

#### Holy Saturday: 8:30 PM

Join us for the Easter Vigil in the evening. Celebrate as the elect and candidates for initiation, who have been preparing for months, are baptized and welcomed into the church!


